Why Share?

Some years ago I was meeting with a group of clergy who were studying the First Letter of John. The first week of our time together we were looking at 1 John 1:3 (see above). It struck me in the middle of that group that I had been thinking about what that verse is talking about in the wrong way. I was assuming that if I shared the faith with someone in the right way then they would embrace the Christian Faith for themselves. The whole point in my mind up until that time was to see individuals come to place their trust in Jesus. It seems though, that there is more to it that that.

A huge part of the Christian Faith is sharing with others who also follow Jesus. In fact, it seems that one of the main points of inviting others to also follow Jesus is the friendship that would result. One of the main reasons for that is we see more of God with each other than we do on our own. The way God is with one person is not the way God is with another. Seeking to share our lives with others is a powerful and authentic witness to the faith we profess.
