I do not ask for these only, but also for those who will believe in me through their word, that they may all be one, just as you, Father, are in me, and I in you, that they also may be in us, so that the world may believe that you have sent me. John 17:20-21

Jesus Prays For You

I am going to start Sunday's sermon with a quiz. Here is the quiz question: What is Jesus doing right now? Answer: Praying. Today being Ascension Day we specifically remember that when He ascended to the right hand of the Father to pray. He is praying right now that the merciful, loving will of God be fulfilled everywhere, all the time, and for every person. With that in mind it is a good idea to join in with what He is praying.

You Are An Answer To HIs Prayers

Notice in the verse above that He is praying that you and I be "in" the Father, Son and Holy Spirit. In other words, that we have a rich communion with God. He will give us the ability to do that. The result will be that people who do not believe Jesus is who He ways He is will come to believe through the way our communion with God is demonstrated. Our communion with God creates "something about us" that will begin to dissolve the cynicism we sometimes find in people around us. What is Jesus asking you to do to maintain an ongoing relationship with Him?
