#### More Faith

The twelve Jesus called to follow Him asked for more faith. He answered with two very unexpected ideas. In the first one He says that even the smallest "amount" of faith would produce some very powerful and miraculous results. One inference we could draw from this answer is that

there is no small or large amounts of faith. You either have faith or you don't. The idea is that you get better and better at living by faith and not by sight.
