

When we commissioned these groups half of the people who showed up for worship were a part of these groups and stood for the commissioning! What a wonderful time it was!!!

Each of these groups is a community of people with a specific mission focus. That is how our faith spreads everywhere. A local church organized as a network of groups like this will bear more fruit than the whole church pursuing one mission focus.

I hope I did not leave any of our efforts out of the list (I'm pretty sure I did so, please forgive me for that). In one way or another we are joining with others and with the Spirit of God to take the mercies of God to new places. We are following His Spirit to those new places, just like the sheep pictured above.
