. . . to you, O Lord, I will make music. Psalm 101:1

### Sacrifice of Praise

Today is the commemoration of Cyril, Bishop of Jerusalem, around 349A.D. He established the observance of certain rituals and practices during Lent and Holy Week. He was given to worship and taught the church, especially those who were about to be baptized, how to live a Christian life including offering to God sacrifices of praise and worship. What strikes me very deeply about this man is that he lived during a time of great political and church conflict. Three times he was banished and restored as the Bishop of Jerusalem. I can imagine Cyril singing, whistling, or having a tune of praise go through his mind no matter what was going on, even through the circumstances in which he was three times banished from his work and his home.

## Sacrifice of Praise from Us

As we enter into Holy Week very soon we will be following the liturgical traditions Cyril first established in the 4th century. There is a powerful, prophetic witness to the love of God in these liturgies. To prepare we might follow what I have imagined to be one of Cyril's personal disciplines: Make music to the Lord any time at all. While you work at your everyday responsibilities whistle any song of praise towards God that comes to mind. Is there a "secular" tune you really enjoy. Offer the melody to God as worship. The Spirit of God might even give you some new words. Open up that part of your life to God. Give it a try. See what happens.
