Wonder and Amazement

The verse above records the response of the crowd which had witnessed the miraculous, public healing of a man who had been lame from birth. Peter and John prayed for this man and everyone saw him get up and start "walking and leaping and praising God (verse 8)." It was an amazingly powerful act. Had I been there I would have been struck with wonder and amazement just like everyone else. The sheer power of that miracle would have been astounding.

Walking and Leaping and Praising God

Something else would have been very easy for me to do as well. I would have wanted to see another miracle, and then another one, and another one after that. I would not have wanted it to stop. My temptation would be to only look for miracles. Peter gave the crowd gathered there the next steps to take. He says, "Repent therefore, and turn again . . . (verse 19)." This can apply to all of us. It can be very tempting to want that wonderful worship experience every time we gather but not desire anything else. A powerful, inspiring worship service is not the same thing as discipleship. An excellent sermon, inspiring songs, and engaging prayers can be very powerful. Raw spiritual power by itself will not be enough to be an effective follower of Jesus. However, just like the power steering system in our cars helps to guide a very powerful engine and vehicle, we will need some power steering fluid in our lives to be able to live a fruitful Christian life. The "power steering fluid" for us is living a life of discipleship. Seeing what Jesus did and doing the same thing is the fluid that helps to guide us along with the power we have received.
