

The photo above is the view I have when I enter my office at St. Francis. The bowl on top of the file cabinet is the baptismal bowl used for baptisms here. I put it there to remind me as soon as I walk into the office to pray for people to come to know Jesus, begin to follow Him, and be baptized. It has been ten years since there was a baptism at St. Francis. It's time to ask the Lord for new Christians to be added to the Church through our fellowship.

Getting There

One of the last things Jesus said during his earthly life was this, "Make disciples of all nations, baptizing them ...". Someone's last words are ususally among the most important ones they speak. As followers of Jesus these words should be very important to us. A place to start working at this, is to ask ourselves this question, "How many people have become Christians at St. Francis?"
