It's Lent

Today is Ash Wednesday. It's the first day of Lent. You have probably thought about what you want to give up, or do. I am encouraging our members and friends at St. Francis to live questionable lives during Lent. I am going to use Michael Frost's book Five Habits of Highly Missional People as a guide. Frost suggest developing five habits that

will help us develop a lifestyle in which people ask us about the love of God. I will highlight one each Sunday of Lent asking our people to take it up as a habit in their own lives. I think it will be a very rich Lent this year.

Here's How It Works

Frost uses the acrostic BELLS. B=bless, E=eat, L=Listen, L=learn, and S=send. Each week we will take up the next habit in the BELLS format. It will proceed like this:

BLESS

I will bless three people this week, at least one of whom is not a member of our church.

EAT

I will eat with three people this week, at least one of whom is not a member of our church.

LISTEN

I will spend at least one period of the week listening for the Spirit's voice.

LEARN

I will spend at least one period of the week learning Christ.

SENT

I will journal throughout the week all the ways I alerted others to the universal reign of God through Christ.

I am looking forward to the stories and the fruit that will come from this.
