In light of all this, here's what I want you to do. While I'm locked up here, a prisoner for the Master, I want you to get out there and walk—better yet, run!—on the road God called you to travel. I don't want any of you sitting around on your hands. I don't want anyone strolling off, down some path that goes nowhere. Ephesians 4:1+2 (The Message)

Running On The Road

This morning one of the readings for Morning Prayer was Ephesians 4:1-6. While the whole Bible speaks to me this is one of the passages that resonates

with me every time I encounter it. The entire section talks about who we are created to be, how we move together to encourage one another, and what the results of living that way will be. That part of the gospel opens up the rest of the gospel for me. It resonates very deeply within my own soul. God has created us to run on a road upon which each of us was called to travel. We do that in a way unique to who we are. That gives us the strength to relate very well to others as we go along together.

Running Further On The Road

What part of the gospel resonates with you? It is forgiveness of sins, release of the gifts of the Spirit, feeding the hungry, encouraging the downcast?
